Ask simple questions to find out more information.


## Key knowledge:

Celebrations are when people meet to share an experience. There is often special food, clothes and music for dancing.


People celebrate bonfire night with bonfires and fireworks. Diwali is a festival of light.

Christmas is a special time for families across the world. People give cards and presents to share their love and kindness.


