Aims of the theme for learning:


- Develop positive relationships with children and adults in nursery.
- Share their knowledge of themselves and others, including information about people in their family (names, relationships, shared experiences...)
- Talk about their play, things they like and dislike and achievements. Talk about feelings and how different experiences make different people feel.
- Listen and respond to what other people say, talking about the same theme of conversation. Speak in a simple sentence. Ask simple questions to find out more information.

Key vocabulary to understand and use in a sentence:

Family, mum/mummy, dad/daddy, brother, sister, grandma... grandad... aunt, uncle, cousin, friends, choice, choose, feelings, happy, excited, sad, sharing, caring. I like... I feel happy when I...

Forming positive relationships with other children and adults is a key area of focus. Talking about our feelings and developing an understanding of how we feel is supported through the stories we share and the games we play. This is an important and ongoing area of focus throughout the year.
