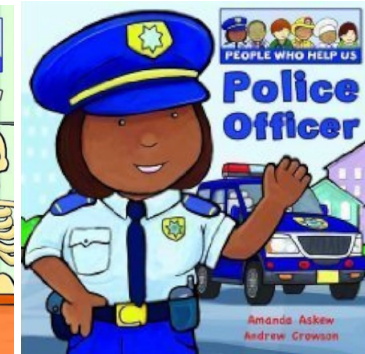
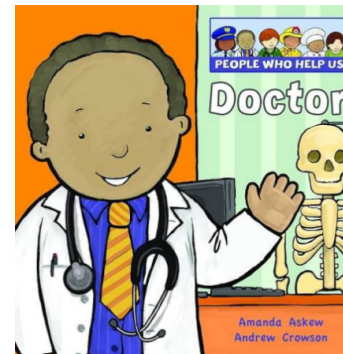
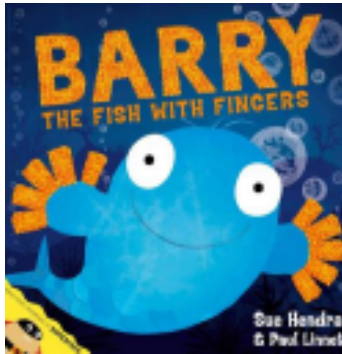
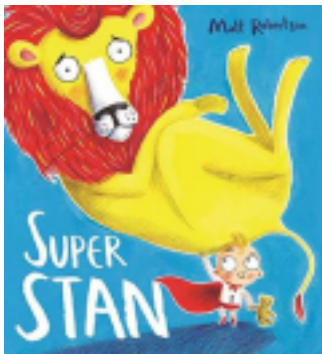


People Who Help Us - Nursery Knowledge Organiser Summer Term - June to July 2024

A focus on effective Learning Characteristics: Achieve self-chosen goals. Develop self-confidence and a sense of responsibility. Develop confidence in front of others, including less familiar people.

Aims of the learning theme: Find out about people in our local community (family, school community, local area) and how their job role involves helping others in different ways. Ask questions to find out more information in response to information shared. Express their growing knowledge and understanding of people in our community in different ways.

Key questions to find out the answers to: Why do people need to help others? Who helps us in our community and how? How can we help others?



Key words and their meaning linked to helping others:

Help and support Making it easier for somebody to do something. **Provide** Give something to somebody.

Healthy Not likely to become ill or sick. **Brave** Doing things that are difficult or dangerous.

Courage Not showing fear when something is scary. **Community** All the people who live in a particular area. **Emergency** – A serious or dangerous event which needs to be dealt with straight away.

Key job roles supported through books and role play. We will also use our own non-fiction books linked to people in our school community (staff, parents, family members) who help others.
